



Frequently Asked Questions for Commercial/Non-Residential Driveway Approach

What is the procedure for constructing a new commercial/non-residential driveway approach?

A site investigation is required for the new commercial/non-residential driveway approach. An application can be submitted to the Permit Counter in City Hall or online at: <http://apps.beverlyhills.org/obc>. The City's Public Works Inspector investigates the commercial site within two (2) business days of the site investigation inspection request being received. The applicant can then apply for a permit at the Permit Center in City Hall (or online via the Online Business Center (OBC) at: <http://apps.beverlyhills.org/obc>) for construction of a new commercial/non-residential driveway approach in accordance with the inspector's recommendations.

What is the width of the driveway approach?

The driveway approach shall be constructed in accordance with City's [BH 102](#) "Non-Residential driveway approach."

Who can construct the driveway approach?

A California Licensed contractor Class A (General Engineering) or Class C-8 (concrete Contractor) is required to complete the work.

When do I call for an inspection?

You can call (310)285-1141 for an inspection after issuance of the permit and after the contractor sets the form for the driveway approach 24 hours in advance. An inspection may also be scheduled by telephone at (310)285-2534 or online via the OBC at: <http://apps.beverlyhills.org/obc>.

Can I extend the driveway approach outside of my side property line extension?

No, you can only construct the driveway approach within your side property line extensions. This includes the wings of the driveway approach.

Can I use colored concrete or different type of material for the driveway approach?

No, the driveway approach should only be concrete and should match the grey color of the existing adjacent sidewalk and curb and gutter.
