Request to Establish an All-Way Stop Control Intersection at Carla Ridge and Arkell Drive

Location: City Hall, 455 N. Rexford Drive, Room 280-A, Beverly Hills, CA, 90210

The City of Beverly Hills has received a request to designate the intersection of Carla Ridge and Arkell Drive an all-way stop intersection. The proposal is to add stop signs facing northbound and southbound traffic on Carla Ridge. Presently, there are stop signs facing eastbound and westbound traffic on Arkell Drive at this location. The all-way stop control is recommended to improve safety and resolve a potential right-of-way visibility problem at this intersection.


