



## TNR PERMIT NOTICE FORM FERAL CAT FEEDER/TRAP

Dear Resident/Owner,

The City of Beverly Hills has been notified that a colony of feral cats exists in your neighborhood and a permit application has been filed to provide a feral cat feeder within 150 feet of your residence. On September 15, 2009, a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) Program was approved by the City Council as a humane method of reducing and controlling the population of feral cat colonies within the City of Beverly Hills. As required by the program, this notice provides a 10 day resident comment period for feeding devices and a 3 day resident comment period for trapping devices to be considered in approving the application filed for a feeding station located at:

### Feral Cat Feeder FAQs

*Is there a limit of time when feeding activity can occur?*

Yes, feeding activity is limited to the hours of 6:00 a.m. through 8:00 p.m., or sunset, whichever is earlier.

*Can food be left out over night for the cats to feed?*

No, all food shall be removed every night by sunset or 8:00pm whichever is earlier.
