The Beverly Hills Police Department Traffic Bureau will be conducting a DUI Saturation Patrol on Friday, December 11, 2009. This specialized patrol detail will put extra officers and patrol cars in the field specifically looking for impaired drivers. The Saturation Patrol will be in operation from 8p.m. on Friday until 2 a.m. on Saturday.

The Beverly Hills Police Department is proud to support the Office of Traffic Safety and Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) in their efforts to reduce the incidents of alcohol related accidents and deaths on our public roadways. According to Lt. Tony Lee, the Beverly Hills Police Department conducts regular DUI checkpoints, DUI saturation patrols, and deploys officers in the field specifically for DUI enforcement thereby creating a safer environment for our community.
