
BACKGROUND (Cont.)

PREVIOUS PROJECTS






RULE 20 A PROJECTS

Remaining locations that qualify for Rule 20 A funding:

- 1) San Vicente Blvd. (west side) – Wilshire Blvd. to Clifton Way (proposed UUD No. 7)**
 - 2) Gregory Way (north side) – Tower Dr. to La Cienega Blvd.**
 - 3) Phyllis St. (southwest side) – Sunset Blvd. to Doheny Dr.**
- Priority approved 11/8/06 by PWC



UUD NO. 7 LOCATION



- **San Vicente Boulevard** (west side) – Clifton Way to Wilshire Boulevard
- **Clifton Way** (both sides) – La Cienega Boulevard to San Vicente Boulevard

POTENTIAL COSTS

Public right-of-way:

- Rule 20 A allocations
- Permits waived

Private Property:

- SCE & AT&T – up to 100 feet to connection
- Time Warner Cable – owner pays or opts out



POTENTIAL COSTS (Cont.)

Rough estimate of potential costs:

- Time Warner Cable work (up to) \$4500
 - Building permits (up to) \$ 500

- Total (up to) \$5000
